PART-TIME HOUSEMOTHER WANTED




Well, we had a new part-time housemother for about six weeks, but she had to leave us to accept a full-time position. So we need to hire a replacement for her.

The part-time housemother would work every other week, from 3 p.m. on Monday until 6 p.m. on Wednesday. She would be required to spend the night on Monday and Tuesday. Her duties would include preparing a meal for the residents one evening, doing light cleaning as needed, and doing daily devotions with the residents. She is basically required to run the house in place of the full-time housemother.

We require a dedicated Christian woman who has a personal relationship with Jesus Christ and a heart to help hurting women. She must be able to take charge with strength and compassion. She should be mission minded and realize that the job is first of all a ministry.



we have had to cut our bare bones budget by almost \$6,000. That is going to hurt. We will still do our best to take care of the women that come into Hannah's House, but some vital things will have to fall by the wayside. We have all of the expenses of running a household and a business, but we don't have a breadwinner to foot the costs. The income that we need to run Hannah's House must come from donors and fund-raisers. We do apply for grants, but because of the Christian message that we teach unashamedly, we aren't eligible to get help from many sources.

We are asking for your help. Make 2011 the year that you donate to the only homeless shelter in the Greater Lansing Area that specifically helps homeless pregnant women. If you cannot do this, please attend one of our fund-raisers this year. How about joining us for the walkathon that we mention on page 1? If you cannot donate money or participate in a fund-raiser, perhaps you could help us with in-kind donations of household goods like bath tissue, paper towel, laundry soap or cleaning supplies.
