I found out last month I was pregnant. It is only six short months until my child is due and I have nothing, nothing at all. Even worse, I just lost my job (because I am pregnant), I have to move (I am already sharing a bedroom in a tiny, two-bedroom with my sister, I know I can't stay here), and the father of the baby disappeared when I mentioned the "p-word" (pregnant). I just hope that God can hear me...

I am happy to report HE did hear her. This young lady found hope, a home, and the Heart of Jesus in the people serving at Hannah's House. This young woman was me thirteen years ago when I found myself very unexpectedly pregnant and completely unprepared. Hannah's House opened the door to a tangible witness of God's unconditional love in my life and allowed me to feel worthy of love beyond my understanding.

It is such an honor, privilege, and blessing to be able to come full-circle and serve the ministry that served me so very long ago in a very dark hour. God bless each and every one of you that supports this ministry, without it I know I would have been lost.

Hannah's House is currently seeking a part-time House Manager. Work hours are from 3:00 p.m. Monday through 6:00 p.m. Wednesday every other week (a total of 4 paid days per month). The house manager is required to spend Monday and Tuesday night in the house. The preferred candidate will be a mature Christian woman who can act as a "mother" and mentor to the women who live at Hannah's House. It is imperative that she has a wealth of compassion

for vulnerable pregnant women and small babies, while maintaining a spirit of accountability. She is required to cook one meal during the shift (Rachel Ray not required) and attend to light housekeeping chores not already assigned to the residents. It is preferred she have her own car and insurance with a good driving record. This position is ministerial in nature, not high-paying, so it would be helpful if the candidate is looking to do ministry or mission work. 
