A Christ-centered transitional shelter for homeless expectant women

I have been a part of Hannah's House for just over a month now, and I have seen God's hand at work in so many ways - from the volunteer groups that come in to donate their time to the many people willing to contribute to this ministry financially to the staff and board members who put their lives into making Hannah's House a place for women and children to call home. What I have found to be the most incredible source of encouragement and strength, however, are the residents themselves. The way they have been transformed since the first day they arrived at Hannah's House is absolutely awe inspiring. I wanted to share with you a small excerpt from a testimony written by one of our residents.

"You see I blamed God for all the bad that had happened to me to cause me to be alone, but really I wasn't aware of His great plan for me. I had become so loved by so many people that I was in awe of the power that Jesus has. I have regained faith like I never had before, and I have so many positive influences that I would not have come into contact with if it wasn't for that fateful phone call that October day. Now, here I am with a permanent marking on my heart for a place that I have called home, not a homeless shelter, for eight months. I feel I am ready. Ready to love God, people, and life in ways I never knew I could. The power of forgiveness has been taught through prayer and long conversations I have had with staff here. "
