A Christ-centered transitional shelter for homeless expectant women

"So do not fear for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous hand." (Isaiah 41:10)

Six and a half years ago my Grandmother, who had been the one I looked to a great deal for guidance and support and brought me to my faith, passed away. It was a time of complete and utter shock and disbelief, and my heart ached to have her back in my life again. I could not imagine not seeing her on holidays, and my birthday, which I had spent with her nearly every year since my birth, would be so empty. I prayed that God would make the pain go away and that I would wake up and it would have all just been an awful nightmare. While God did not give my Grandma back to me, He did help me to deal with the grief and loss that I was feeling. During a time I felt I would not make it through, God gave me the strength to come out on the other side and to even support other people in my family to do the same. While living at Hannah's House, our residents are dealing with a number of issues- from homelessness and poverty to abandonment and abuse. It is our hope and prayer that as they journey down the path that God has laid out for them here at Hannah's House, that they turn over their fears, worries, and burdens to the one who can make all things possible. It is our prayer that they lean on God for strength and healing and trust that He is the way. Maybe someday, as they venture out on their own and begin their lives with their babies, they can reach out to someone else and show them how much God has impacted their lives. Thank you for showing the love of Christ through your generous time, donations, and prayer support.
