The last six months have been a whirlwind of emotion at Hannah's House for me. In March, I gave birth to a precious baby boy. In May, I came back from maternity leave full-time and was faced with the possibility of our doors closing. As I write today, I am preparing for our largest fundraiser of the year. Thrown in between have been births at Hannah's House, residents moving out and new residents moving in, visiting and catching up with previous residents, staff, and volunteers, sickness, loss, baby showers, weddings, and more. It has indeed been a ride of uncertainty, but also a huge testament to how incredible our God is and what He has promised us.

Through everything God has sustained me personally, giving me the strength and energy to keep moving forward. He has touched the hearts of so many who have poured out their time and given so freely of their finances to support Hannah's House. He has brought together a community that has spoken about their desire to keep Hannah's House as a part of the community, and that is just what has happened. We now begin our 20th year of service to the greater Lansing area, helping to house, feed, and lovingly guide homeless, pregnant women and their babies.
